## We Treat Kids Like a Million Dollars

In 1989, we formalized our mission by forming the Texas Cavaliers Charitable Foundation. King Antonio and his royal court dedicate hundreds of volunteer hours to this great community, spreading a spirit of lighthearted fun and reminding us that play is essential to our well-being.

Other ways we raise the funds to build a better life for local children: memorials and special gifts from our members to honor friends and family, the Endowment Fund, the Lewis Hart Society, Silver Knights, New Member Auction, Annual Fishing Weekend, Annual Golf Tourna-

ment and Adopt-A-Charity. Together with the Fiesta River Parade, we continue to build the corpus of our Foundation. We launched the Foundation with \$14,000 in 1989 and have grown this fund from which we draw our charitable gifts to \$3.5 million in 2017.

# The Winston School

## Educating Special Children to their Highest Potential

The Texas Cavaliers Charitable Foundation selected The Winston School as its featured charity in 2017, awarding a record \$285,000 grant to the private, independent school with a mighty mission.

A stroll around the campus and through the hallways of The Winston School tells you everything you need to know. This place is distinctive. Teachers and administrators have a passion for their work. Students from kindergarten through senior high are smart, creative, engaged, motivated, supported, accepted and accepting of each other. Their experiential approach to learning imbues this campus with remarkable energy.

Students know they are special: Each has been identified with a learning difficulty as well as the high potential for success. Here, they are given the individualized support and environment they need, under the guidance of a faculty that understands variations in learning. That's what The Winston School has been doing since 1985.

Students are enthusiastically involved in STEAM (science, technology, engineering, arts, mathematics) and community service. They are excelling and competing in robotics, performing arts, athletics and more. They serve as mentors and role models for younger students on campus.

Dr. Charles Karulak, Headmaster, says, "Students who come in with low self-esteem find confidence and self-reliance. More than 90% go to college. Some join the military. Others go directly into the work force. All discover their gifts and leave us with the tools to succeed and self-advocate."

Students whose learning would likely be hampered in a traditional school setting are nurtured here and they blossom. Their families experience the joy of their achievements. For the 22% who need assistance, the school provides financial aid.

The Texas Cavaliers Charitable Foundation grant will help expand the school's performing and visual arts programs, digital media and black box theater. Our gift will help them reach their capital campaign goal of \$9.78 million to expand and transform the campus.

Bart Simpson, Parade Marshal, said: "The Texas Cavaliers Foundation selected The Winston School because it provides for children who might otherwise be overlooked. This is a place for students to excel well beyond ordinary expectations. Winston teachers reach these kids and bring them to their highest potential. Our gift, presented during Fiesta, put The Winston School at the forefront in the media, raising awareness and support and we feel really grateful for the ability to do that, to make a difference. It's what our charitable mission is all about."

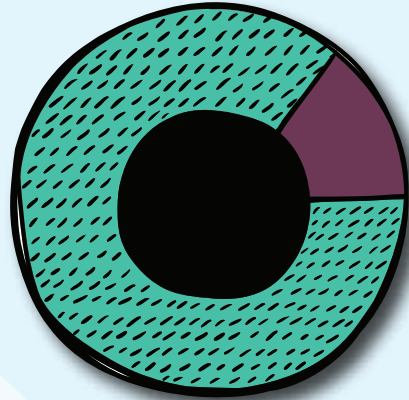

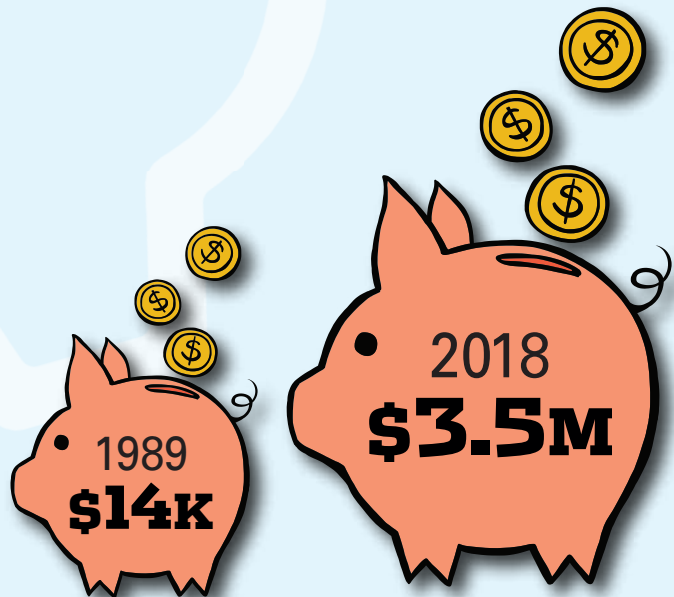
